



Roller Towne Day Camp

Information and Agreement Application

Check-in:

Parents (Guardian) **MUST** accompany your child into the facility, and are required to sign child in, and out along with the date, and time of drop off as they attend each camp session.

Check-out:

Parents (Guardian) are required to show picture I.D for the safety of your child (**NO EXCEPTIONS**). The only adults that are permitted to pick up your child are those who are listed on the emergency or contact list. ALL campers must be picked up by the end of each camp session, 12:00pm or 5:00pm. If for any reason you are unable to pick your child up by the closing time of camp, please contact one of the authorized persons on your Emergency contact form. If late, a fee will be added for every additional minute.

Electronics:

Roller Towne Day Camp is not responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged items. It is strongly encouraged that you leave cell phones & electronics at home.

Food:

We ask that parents prepare a nutritious lunch or snack for your child. We will be providing a small combination snack during their visit. Roller Towne's snack bar, and vending items will also be available during the duration of the campers stay for purchase. (**NOTE.** For the safety of your child, and our staff. Please note down **ANY** type of food allergies your child has that camp counselors should be aware of.

Medical, Emergency Information:

If your child has any medication that is needed to take as scheduled please note down exactly what needs to be taken. The camp reserves the right to share medical information with all staff members when necessary. If certain symptoms appear or if an accident occurs, that needs further medical treatment at camp, a parent or guardian will be contacted from the emergency contact list.

Refunds/Cancellations:

There will be **NO** Refund at any time during the camp session for a campers absence. Summer Camp reserves the right to cancel enrollment of any camper who does not demonstrate reasonable age appropriate standards of behavior (as determined by the camp)

Injury:

If at anytime your child is hurt while participating in activities, we will do the best to our ability to handle any situation. If your child needs further medical assistance, our staff will call a parent or guardian on the emergency list for further assistance.
